

“Weather Nowcasting” – 1 October 2015

Activity Guide

Use your...

[a] eyes

[b] ears

[c] nose (& mouth)

[d] fingers (hands)

to ‘read’ the current sky and weather conditions to aid in making a short-term weather forecast for Asheville, NC; predicting how cloud cover and cloud type, wind speed and direction, chance of precipitation, air temperature, pressure, and humidity might change over the next 0-6 hours.

We’ll return indoors to see how accurate a forecast we could make using the five senses by comparing our short-term weather forecasts to current weather maps.
